Rashtrasant Janardhan swami foundation, At.Po. Bet, Tal. Kopargaon, Dist- Ahmednagar has applied for establishment of Rashtrasant Janardhan swami Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre, At- Kokamthan, Taluka-Kopargaon, Dist- Ahamadnagar. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Maharashtra has decided to issue No Objection Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of an Ayurved college with 100 seats.

It is certified that :-

- (a) The applicant owns & manages 100 Bedded Hospital which was established in 2015.
- (b) It is desirable to establish an Ayurved college in the public interest for starting BAMS course.
- (c) Establishment of Ayurved college with 100 admission capacity BAMS course at Rashtrasant Janardhan swami Ayurved Medical College & Research Centre, At- Kokamthan, Taluka-Kopargaon, Dist- Ahamadnagar is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine is available with the proposed Ayurved College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurved college as per Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.

This Certificate is Valid for a period of 3 years from academic year 2020-21, thereafter it will automatically lapse.
